Wm. Schober Sons, Inc. is a fourth-generation family fruit farm. In 1896, William Frederick Schober ventured into farming in Monroeville, New Jersey. In 1924 William was chosen the Master Farmer of the State by the New Jersey Department of Agriculture. William and three of his four sons operated fruit orchards, growing apples and peaches. At his passing in 1949, sons Harry, Frank and Edward continued the farming operation. The business has stayed in the family for over one hundred years. Today, the farm continues to produce apples, peaches and nectarines.
